FALL TASK FORCE DATA REVIEW MARCH 7TH 2017

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ED FALLS SCREENING CHECK

- 11/01/2015-10/31/2016
- Total ED encounters for that time was 31048
 - 22707 separate MRNs (some patients came in more that once)
- Of those 7511 encounters (5538 MRN's) were 64 YOA or older (about 24 %)
- Of those 6594 encounters (5019 MRNs) were not given the discharge falls screening tool (88%)
- The remainder 917 encounters (855 MRN's) were given the discharge falls screening tool (12%)

ED FALLS SCREENING CHECK

- Of the patients 64 YOA and older there 441 encounters with a "FALL" MOI. (5% of the $64 \ge yoa$).
- Add 447 encounters with a potential for a <u>fall related</u> MOI (e.g. fracture, head injury, neck injury) you get 888 (12%). (they may have come with a fracture due to a fall but was recorded as the diagnosis and not the MOI)
- Of only the "Fall MOI" only 23 came for two fall events and one came in three times. (only 5% of the 441 Falls MOI patients).

• Total 65: 2369 (~592/year avg)




• 66 patients had two admissions for fall MOI (3/2%)

• 8 patients had three admissions for fall MOI (<1%)


2013-2016 ALL MOI




2013-2106 65 YOA




2014-2016 ALL MOI VS ALL 65
